The incumbent to this position must be committed to a community development philosophy, embrace the Primary Health Care Model and demonstrate the ability to be a team player.

Project Coordinator will work as a team with a Nurse Practitioner, Registered Practical Nurse and X-ray/Lab Technician who will work collaboratively with existing CHNs, itinerant physicians and community health staff and leadership to provide timely and comprehensive response to local health service needs.
